TUESDAY 5TH APRIL 2016 MARKET REPORT

There was an excellent show of cattle this week at Malton with an increase in stock across all departments with some very good clean cattle through the ring. With a good range of types and weights, prices topped 250ppk and this week saw a good entry of OTM's and Cows. There was strong Hogg numbers again with heavier and fit pens selling well and cull ewes remaining a very good trade with prices consistently topping £100.

24 steers averaged 176.03ppk and topped at 215.50ppk (£1574)

8 young bulls averaged 160.78ppk and topped at 199.50ppk (£1292)

26 heifers averaged 198.57ppk and topped at **250.50ppk** (£1353)

33 OTM cattle topped at 189.50 (£1270)

1836 Hogs averaged 183.08ppk and topped at £118.00 (220.00ppk)

25 Spring Lambs averaged **257.96ppk** and topped at £117 (269.00ppk)

215 cull ewes averaged **£94.23** and topped at £120.00

8 YOUNG BULLS

More bulls forward this week with the top price per kilo going to a Lim from RH Mason of Wold Newton, weighing 585kg and selling for 199.50ppk (£1167) to Cleveland Meat Co of Stockton on Tees. The top price per head went to a heavier Stabiliser from Knapton Wold Farm of West Knapton, weighing 820kg and selling for £1292 (157.50ppk). There was an excellent entry of OTM's and Cows this week at Malton with the largest entry of the year to date. A 32 month old Lim steer from P Raines & Son of Stonegrave, weighing 670kg, topped both the price per kilo and per head at 189.50ppk (£1270). A 150 month old AA from ID Watson Farmers of Fadmoor sold for 109.50ppk (£695) and a 60 month Lim from the same home reached 128.50ppk (£720) A 108 month old BAX from R & E Hall of Cranswick, weighing 685kg, sold for 118.50ppk (£812). As strong Hogg numbers continue at Malton, trade for good, fit pens remains firm with heavier Hogs in particular selling well. The top price per head went to a pen of 9 from JP Mason & Sons of Langton, weighing 65kg and selling for £118.00 (182.00ppk) to Worsley Wholesale Butchers of Bristfield. Other pens to top £110 included a pen of 9 from CF Beal of Yedingham, weighing 63kg and selling for £115, a pen of 5 from D & E Newham of Burniston, weighing 65kg and selling for £113 and a pen of 10 from EW Jackson & Son of Grindale, weighing 56kg and selling for £112.50 (201.00ppk).
