## TUESDAY 3<sup>RD</sup> MAY 2016 MARKET REPORT

As sunshine returned to Malton there was an improved entry of bulls and an increase in the average pence per kilo price of clean cattle. There were some good heifers through the ring as 'handy weight' beasts sold well and cows remain a firm trade. Good, fit pens of Hoggs continue to be a good trade and there was another increased show of spring lambs.

16 steers averaged 191.92ppk and topped at 211.50ppk (£1442)

15 young bulls averaged 162.62ppk and topped at 195.50 (£1187)

21 heifers averaged 198.03ppk and topped at 239.50ppk (£1354)

13 OTM cattle topped at **156.50ppk (£1385)**

1692 Hoggs averaged 169.96 and topped at £110.00 (227.00ppk)

232 Spring Lambs averaged 211.59ppk and topped at £104.00 (248.00ppk)

210 cull ewes averaged £78.47 and topped at £112.00

### 15 YOUNG BULLS

There were more bulls on offer this week as the top price per kilo went to an excellent 12 month old BB from J & AM Craggs of Ebberston, weighing 545kg and selling for 195.50ppk (£1065) to Cleveland Meat Co. of Stockton on Tees. ## **13 OTM CATTLE**

There were more OTM cattle forward this week as trade remains firm for cull cows. There were slightly fewer Hogs forward this week although there was an improved trade. The top price per head went to a pen of 9 from M D Medd of Sawdon, weighing 60kg and selling for £110.00 (183.00ppk) to Worsley Wholesale Butchers of Bristfield. Other pens to top £100 included a pen of 11 from CF Beal of Yedingham, weighing 64kg and selling for £101.00 and a pen of 8 from J R Cussons & Son of Fylingdales, weighing 67kg and

selling for £100.00.
